| 12 | <u>Graduation</u> – Students who plan to complete their program in the summer should apply to graduate either for the preceding or following May, as the August ceremony will no longer be held. Those students with 7 or fewer credits to complete during the summer will be permitted to walk in the preceding May ceremony. Those students with greater than 7 credits to complete during the summer will be able to walk the following May. |
| 14 | <u>Health Insurance Fee</u> – The Student Health Insurance Fee will be \$75 per term for the 2005-2006 academic year. |
| 15 | <u>Refund of Tuition and Fees</u> – An additional level of 75% has been added in the refund process. A student withdrawing from The College after the official end of Add/Drop but before the end of the third week of classes in the fall and spring semesters shall receive a 75 percent refund of applicable tuition and fees* paid. *See www.tcnj.edu/~stuacct for more information. |
| 34 | <u>Master of Arts in Speech and Language Pathology</u> – Codes for the undergraduate prerequisite requirements have changed from SPAU to SLP (ie: SLP 305/Acoustic Phonetics). In addition, the undergraduate prerequisite requirement of SPED 101 has been replaced by SPE 103/Social and Legal Foundations of Special Education. |
