A portfolio review must be completed for all Art applicants (with the exception of the Art History program). Biology^Δ:

For full consideration, all Biology applications should be submitted no later than January 1st.

This includes students for the following programs:

- Biology - Teacher Preparation
- Elementary Education - Biology
- Early Childhood Education - Biology
- Education of the Developmentally Handicapped - Biology
- Education of the Deaf/Hard of Hearing – Biology

Music:

Music majors will be required to audition in person with the Department of Music. Therefore, Music applications must be received by November 1st for Early Decision and February 1st for General Decision. Seven-Year Medical Program^Δ:

Students must have a minimum SAT score of 1400 on the Critical Reading and Math sections from ONE test date and rank in the top 10% of their high school class to be considered for Seven-year Medical Programs. These applications must be submitted no later than January 1st.

Seven-Year Optometry Program^Δ:

Students must have a minimum SAT score of 1300 on the Critical Reading and Math sections and rank in the top 10% of their high school class to be considered for Seven-year Optometry Programs. All applications for the seven-year optometry program must be submitted by January 1st.

^Δ These applicants will be notified on a non-rolling basis.

In addition to the standard required information, International students must also submit:

- **TOEFL** (Test of English as a Foreign Language) Scores: TOEFL is required if English is not your native language. A score of 550 is recommended, 213 on the computer-based exam.
- Completed **Affidavit of Support Forms**: These forms can be obtained on the International Applicant website.
- **Financial Information Form**: Also included in the International Student Applicant website, this form verifies full funding for your education. *Note that financial aid and scholarships are not available to international students.*
- **Transcripts**: Applicants are required to submit ALL Transcripts. Transcripts must be submitted to a United States agency that provides foreign credentials evaluations before being sent to TCNJ.
- **Doctor's Certification**: This certification is used to determine if you are in good health and have had your vaccinations.
- A **WASC Transcript** if you are an applicant from West Africa.
