AREA OF CONCENTRATION OPTIONS

1. Exercise Science and Scientific Foundations.

Designed for the physical educator with responsibilities in modified activity programs. Directed toward the assessment of physical limitations and status. Involves planning individualized programs that require specialized personnel and services. Select four or a total of twelve credit hours of the following courses: PHED 500, 530, 597, 633, 646, 650, .

2. Administration of Physical Education and Athletic Management.

Designed to prepare individuals for administrative positions in health, physical education, and athletics. Directed toward the study of purposes, policies, and procedures involved in the process of administering such programs. Select four or a total of twelve credit hours of the following courses: HLED 521; PHED 500, 511, 530, 534, 610, 612, 633, 646.

3. Elementary and Secondary School Physical Education.

Designed for the elementary or secondary school physical educator. Emphasis is placed upon the study of physical education programs consistent with current trends or academic enrichment value. Select four or a total of twelve credit hours of the following courses: PHED 500, 510, 511, 603, 612, 646.
