

## GRE Waiver Policy

---

Effective: Summer 2009 for applicants seeking Spring 2010 matriculation.

The GRE is to be waived for applicants to master's degree programs\* (see asterisk for exclusions below) if the applicant meets one of the following criteria:

- already has an earned graduate level degree (master's or other higher-level degree);
- earned a bachelor's degree from The College of New Jersey (TCNJ) with at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA;
- earned a bachelor's degree from another regionally accredited college/university (and NLN- or CCNE-accredited for nursing) with at least a 3.2 cumulative GPA;
- is a current undergraduate at TCNJ with at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA; or
- earned at least a 3.5 cumulative GPA (with no grades lower than B) at TCNJ through 2 graduate courses (courses may be specified by a program – for nursing, one of the two courses must be NURS 504/ Advanced Pathophysiology) in any non-matriculated status or through a certification program – the most recent academic experience at TCNJ will prevail

\* For MA Counselor Education programs and the MEd Educational Leadership: Instruction program offered in conjunction with Regional Training Center, the GRE is waived only for those candidates who have already earned a graduate level degree (master's or other higher-level degree).
