

History Minor Requirements

Students should take five courses, most likely at the 300-level. No more than one course at the 200-level. The three 100-level foundational courses are reserved for History majors, though History minors may enroll if space is available. Occasionally a teacher may admit a History minor to a Seminar (a 400-level course), if space is available. The five courses should include at least three of the department's seven geographical categories: Asia, Middle East, Eurasia, Africa, Latin America, North America, or Europe.
