

The Commandments According to Pfeiffer

1. Thou shalt submit all assignments on 8.5 x 11 inch standard size paper.
2. Thou shalt write thy name and the problem number at the top of each page.
3. Remember to staple together only the pages of a given problem in the upper left corner
4. Thou shalt not staple together the pages of different problems.
5. Thou shalt write on one side of each page only.
6. Thou shalt write legibly and coherently the annotations of a problem.
7. Thou shalt reference any equation or law used in the problem. E. G., From the ideal gas law, from RJP (2-5.2), from S&S (4-20)
8. Thou shalt solve an equation for the unknown quantity before substituting any numbers into the equation.
9. Thou shalt not substitute an equation for a variable into another equation and then insert the numbers into a ridiculously and impossible equation to read.
10. Thou shalt not write in such a way that things are crammed together.
11. Thou shalt not covet thy classmate's computer program or solution to a problem.
