



U.S. SBA 504 Loan Program Financing For Capital Assets Financial and Technical Assistance for Small Businesses

The CDC/504 loan program is a long-term financing tool for economic development within a community. It provides growing businesses with long-term, fixed-rate financing for major fixed assets, such as land and buildings up to 6 million.

If your business qualifies as small and does not have a tangible net worth in excess of \$7.5 million and does not have an average net income in excess of \$2.5 million after taxes for the preceding two years you could be eligible to apply.
