

Our Services

- **Alcohol-Awareness Programs/Enforcement:** Using a proactive approach, the department has police officers partner with the members of the Campus Community and our neighbors to provide educational programs regarding the problems associated with alcohol abuse and to identify problem areas. Campus police officers enforce state and local laws regarding intoxicated drivers and underage alcohol usage, arresting and charging violators.
 - **Bicycle and Foot Patrols:** Bicycle and Foot patrols are conducted by police officers and security officers to deter crime and strengthen the Department's relationship with the Community it serves. A strong relationship with the Community is a key element of crime prevention.
 - **Bicycle Registration Program and Property Marker:** Community members are encouraged to register their bicycle with the TCNJ PD. The Department makes available, upon request, a free engraving tool which members of the Community can use to mark their property. These programs provide a visual deterrent and aid in the recovery of stolen property.
 - **Blue Emergency Light Telephones:** Blue emergency light telephones (18) have been placed in locations around The College of New Jersey campus for use by the public and provide a direct link to the Communications Desk. Police Officer/Security Officers respond whenever these phones are activated.
 - **Campus Lighting Checks:** To ensure maximum lighting for the public at night, police officers complete a comprehensive campus lighting check every week and submit a report to Facilities to have burnt out or damaged street and building lights repaired as soon as possible.
 - **Crime Alert Notices and Campus Police Information:** It is the policy of The College to make timely warnings whenever there is a threat posed to the Campus Community. Warnings may come in the form of text messages, a campus-wide e-mail, special meeting, or other such general advertisement. Keeping the Community informed and aware as to the nature and volume of offenses reported on campus constitutes one of our most valuable crime prevention efforts. One way we do this is with the regular release of information to the campus newspaper The Signal, for their weekly "Cop Shop" column. The College of New Jersey Office of Campus Police Services publishes an Annual Security Report, required under the Jeanne Clery Campus Security Act, which includes information on but is not limited to, three years of crime statistics, Alcohol Policies, Drug Policies, Sexual Health Programs and Policies, Alcohol and Drug Education Program (ADEP), and Important Telephone Numbers.
 - **Crime Prevention Programs:** The Department works with the College Community to reduce and prevent crime, offering crime prevention presentations and sponsoring campus police information booths at many events such as Wellness Fairs, Accepted Students Day, Welcome Week, and other expos. For these events, officers obtain and distribute crime prevention materials and discuss the many services offered by the department. These types of duties are often done in conjunction with other local law enforcement agencies, thus promoting cooperation between various law enforcement agencies in the area and presenting a combined proactive response to crime.
 - **Escort Program:** The Department provides escorts for members of the campus Community who have concerns for their personal safety. Escorts are conducted by the department's police and security officers, using bicycles, on foot or by vehicle. Escorts can be arranged by calling the Communications desk at 771-2167.
 - **Traffic Enforcement:** The College of New Jersey Police Officers conduct traffic enforcement in regards to violations of New Jersey State Motor Vehicle Laws Title 39 and enforce all TCNJ Parking Regulations.
